The purpose of the paper is to clarify theoretical requirements and fundamentals of teacher professional development and students' readiness to collaborate in order to form future leaders as a part of it in the modern society.

According to the purpose certain **tasks** are defined. They are as follows:

- to define synergy as an essential phenomenon in modern teaching;
 - to specify the parts of collaboration;

 - value other people's opinions and ideas;
 - consider differences and reconsider your ideas.
